

# Brown Trout Tagging Study

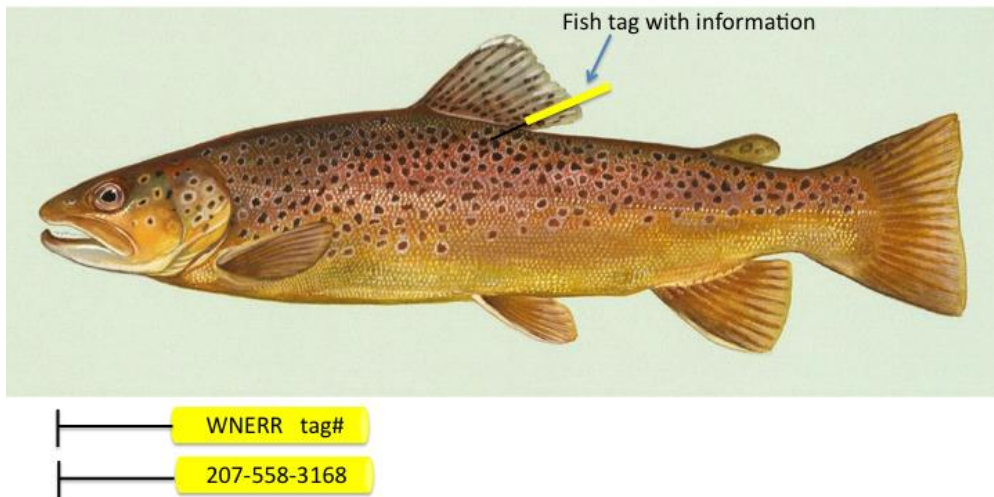
## Mousam River, Fall 2017

### WHAT IS THIS PROJECT ABOUT?

This fall, with funding from the Maine Outdoor Heritage Fund we have tagged a portion of the sea-run brown trout stocked into the Mousam River estuary with external tags (yellow tags in picture) and some with internally implanted acoustic tags. The acoustic tags emit a signal the biologists can track to determine where and when the fish are moving with the goal of improving Maine Dept. of Inland Fish and Wildlife stock enhancement of sea-run brown trout. The brown trout are from DIFW's hatchery and were reared under different environmental conditions.
