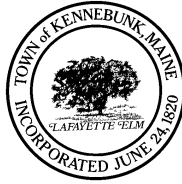

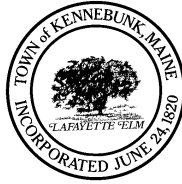

Old Business: Discussion regarding virtual presentation of the Bicentennial events in June of 2021 rather than public gathering events.

1. Freed Slave Settlement dig, artifacts and progress.
2. Museum in the Streets with actors at each sign.
3. Celebration day with take-out dinners from the restaurants or caterers we had already lined up. To include a message from the Committee, a Message from Mike Pardue, a display of the 1920 Time capsule (if located) and a display of the New Time Capsule and contents.
4. Local restaurants can have curbside take out signature beverages.
5. Locals can be asked to write a letter to be included in the new Time Capsule.
6. Virtual display of the Bicentennial quilt with taped dialog from each quilter.
7. Souvenirs may be sold at local businesses and town hall.
8. Buntings yet to be purchased can be hung on Main Street for the summer.

New Business:

1. Vote to proceed with virtual events rather than public gatherings in light of the pandemic.
2. Inclusion of a militia element as a virtual event.
