**CALL TO ORDER**

**BUDGET AND GOALS**

The Commission's budget for the next fiscal year was discussed and adopted. Members also developed the Commission's goals for the coming year. These are:

- Pass the Wetland Mitigation Ordinance and work with the Planning Board to implement it
- Continue to review site plans and developments with environmental impacts and provide recommendations to the Site Plan Review Board and the Planning Board
- Provide a citizen training on vernal pools in spring 2021
- Continue to support the water quality testing in both rivers and on the beaches
- Work toward town approval of manual clearing of Central Maine Power's power line easements
- Continue to participate in the Branch Brook Consortium to support the efforts to protect our drinking water
- Continue to participate in the Kennebunk River Watershed Management Project to support the efforts to improve the water quality in the Kennebunk River Watershed

**WETLANDS MITIGATION ORDINANCE**

John Stoll asked Lee Jay Feldman at the Southern Maine Planning and Development Council for feedback on the ordinance. His feedback was discussed.

**SITE PLANS AND DEVELOPMENTS:** There were no developments to review. It was decided to create a checklist for reviewing developments in the future. Bridgeo will create a first draft of this.

**OTHER MEETINGS:** Branchina will attend the next meeting for the Kennebunk River Watershed Management Project.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** There was no new business.
