Sub Committee Reports:

Parade—applications, rules, judging, parade route, are in the final stages of development and will be shared with the Committee once completed

Quilt—applications are nearly complete. It is anticipated that two quilts may be completed. One to donate to the Brick Store and one to raffle.

Map—well under construction

Banners—working with the high school. There will be 36 banners.

Scholarship—A \$2,020 will be awarded. Details being worked on.

Block Party—The plan is for 50-100 tables on Main Street with 8 seats each table. Details being worked on.

Artist Collaborative - have met with the Kennebunk Art guild to suggest they contemplate how they would like to be involved on the day of the Block Party. All agree that there should be an ART element to the celebration and perhaps, even an art installation as a legacy to the event and our efforts.
