BOARD OF SELECTMEN WORKSHOP - MINUTES

APRIL 30, 2019 – 6:30 P.M.

1. Call to Order

On Wednesday, April 30 2019, at 6:31 p.m., in Room 301 of the Town Hall, Richard Morin, Chair of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Kennebunk, called to order the Workshop of the Board of Selectmen. Present were Selectmen Richard Morin, L. Blake Baldwin, Edward Karytko, Wayne Berry, William Ward, Jr., Christopher Cluff and Shiloh Schulte.

Also present was Town Manager Michael Pardue and Town Engineer and Director of Community Development Chris Osterrieder.

2. Review of Street Scan Initiative

The purpose of the workshop was to hear a presentation by Town Engineer and Director of Community Development Chris Osterrieder on the data generated through the “Street Scan” initiative. Street Scan is a program designed to assess current road pavement conditions, along with aiding in future decisions related to the Town’s pavement management plan.

Mr. Osterrieder provided the Board with a set of documents to refer to during his comments, which included a PowerPoint presentation. The Board engaged in healthy dialogue concerning the condition of various roads within the community.

The Board discussed their need for an agreed upon philosophical approach to funding road restoration and ways to budget for such a plan.
