5. Review status of brochure distribution: The KDAC brochures have been distributed to area hotels in Kennebunk & Kennebunkport dog friendly hotels. D. He discussed combining marine & animal waste, grants, & pilot projects. The EPA will be looking for volunteers who have property near the beaches to do a pilot program. Their goal is to collect marine waste. E. Fagan stated she lives near the marsh & would be glad to volunteer her property. L. Miller- Clearly will inform the dog waste committee of E. Fagan's offer.
