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TOWN REFERENDUM QUESTION 1

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$12,843,385 for General Government Services (Selectmen, Town Clerk's Office, Assessor's Office, Town Manager's Office, Office/Administration, Community Development Division, Town Hall Maintenance, Computer Department, Social Services, Employee Benefits, Kennebunk Free Library, Boards and Commissions, and Agencies), Public Safety (Police/Communications, Harbormaster, Fire, Ambulance, Lifeguards, and Civil Emergency Preparedness), Public Services (Highway, Recycling, Hazardous Waste Day, Hydrants and Street Lights, Parks, Recreation, and Recreation Facilities), and Debt Service (principal and interest of notes, bonds & lease/purchase payments) with \$4,469,600 to be funded from estimated revenues, \$100,000 from unassigned general fund balance ("surplus"), \$4,000 from restricted trust fund balance, and \$8,269,785 to be raised by assessment.

TOWN REFERENDUM QUESTION 2

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the unassigned general fund balance ("surplus") the sum of \$896,000 and to appropriate the same for the purchase, rental and/or repair of capital vehicles and equipment; Town Hall, Fire Department Central Station, and Police Station lighting and landscaping projects; road cracksealing, gravel, culvert and basin projects; reserves for the Town's 2020 bicentennial celebration; reserves to be used to reduce current and future debt service; and to reduce the Pay-As-You-Throw solid waste enterprise fund deficit balance.

TOWN REFERENDUM QUESTION 3

To see if the Town will vote to approve a general obligation bond borrowing, notes in anticipation of such bonds or lease/purchase agreements, of up to \$770,000, or combination thereof as determined by the Board of Selectmen, for the purpose of financing costs of acquisition and equipping of Public Services plow/dump truck, and a Fire/EMS Department fire truck, hereby authorized, with the bonds and notes to be issued with or without call provisions and with such dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s), redemption provisions and other details (including provisions that the bonds may be subject to call for redemption with or without premium) as the Municipal Officers shall determine (total estimated debt service of \$887,783 of which principal is \$770,000 and estimated interest at 3.50% over 10 years is \$117,783) and to accept any monetary or in-kind donations and grants for these assets or projects.

TOWN REFERENDUM QUESTION 4

To see if the Town will vote to approve a general obligation bond borrowing and notes in anticipation of such bonds of up to \$480,000, for the purpose of financing costs of road paving and drainage repair or replacement to Holland Road, Longview Terrace, Clearbrook Crossing and Perkins Lane and related improvements, and other public streets in the Town if funds permit, hereby authorized, with the bonds and notes to be issued with or without call provisions and with such dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s), redemption provisions and other details (including provisions that the bonds may be subject to call for redemption with or without premium) as the Municipal Officers shall determine (total estimated debt service of \$565,423 of which principal is \$480,000 and estimated interest at 3.50% over 10 years is \$85,423) and to accept any monetary or in-kind donations and grants for these assets or projects.

TOWN REFERENDUM QUESTION 5

To see if the Town will vote to approve a general obligation bond borrowing and notes in anticipation of such bonds of up to \$2,686,000 for the purpose of financing costs of site improvements, construction, replacement, equipping, and repair of the Town Garage, and the Solid Waste Transfer and Recycling Facility, hereby authorized, with the bonds and notes to be issued with or without call provisions and with such dates, maturities, denominations, interests rate(s), redemption provisions and other details (including provisions that the bonds may be subject to call for redemption with or without premium) as the Municipal Officers shall determine (total estimated debt service of \$3,397,953 of which principal is \$2,686,000 and estimated interest at 3.50% over 15 years is \$711,953) and to accept any monetary or in-kind donations and grants for these assets or projects.

To see if the Town will vote to approve a general obligation bond borrowing and notes in anticipation of such bonds, of up to \$1,375,000 for the purpose of financing costs of road paving and/or improvement projects on Summer Street, Dane Street, and Portland Road and related improvements, hereby authorized, with the bonds and notes to be issued with or without call provisions and with such dates, maturities, denominations, interests rate(s), redemption

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provisions and other details (including provisions that the bonds may be subject to call for redemption with or without premium) as the Municipal Officers shall determine (total estimated debt service of \$1,705,014 of which principal is \$1,375,000 and estimated interest at 3.50% over 15 years is \$330,014) and to accept any monetary or in-kind donations and grants for these assets or projects.
