State Referendum Question 1: Citizen Initiative

Johnson, Trustee of the Johnson Property Trust, to C & K Realty Corporation, dated February 25, 2016 and recorded in the York County Registry of Deeds in Book 17191, Page 469; the covenant states: "the structure on the land being conveyed, the "Barnard Tavern," so-called, may not be torn down" and is enforceable by the Town and the original Grantor of the deed.
