

A summary of the community workshop(s), including an agenda, participant list, priority action list, and a description of the steps taken ensure robust community engagement and participation of diverse community voices.

The Kennebunk Select Board held a workshop on Tuesday, March 1, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss the Community Resilience Partnership and engage the public in a discussion about Kennebunk's climate goals and objectives.

The workshop was publicly noticed and held via videoconferencing platform Zoom (see attached agenda and minutes).

In addition to Select Board members, town staff and members of the public participated in a discussion about what Kennebunk is doing well regarding climate issues, areas for improvement and focus in the short and long-term, and specific action areas.

Discussion points centered on aspects of the following Community Resilience Partnership Action Areas:

- Embrace the Future of Transportation
- Modernize Maine's Buildings
- Reduce Emissions through Clean Energy Innovation
- Protect the Environment & Promote Natural Climate Solutions
- Build Healthy & Resilient Communities
- Engage Maine People

Specifically, Select Board members referenced acknowledging and addressing economic impacts related to climate change and sea level rise, natural resource protection and enhancement and community engagement strategies.
