TOWN REFERENDUM

Referendum Question A: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$30,055,182, with some but not all of that to be raised by taxation as detailed more fully below, for General Government Services (Select Board, Town Clerk's Office, Ballot Clerks, Assessor's Office, Town Manager's Office, General Government/Finance and Administration, Human Resources, Community Development Office, Town Hall, Computer Department, Social Services/General Assistance, Employee Benefits, Boards and Commissions, Kennebunk Free Library, and Agencies), Public Safety (Police, Communications, Fire/EMS, Civil Emergency Preparedness, Lifeguards), Public Services (Highway, Recycling, Solid Waste, Hydrants/Street Lights, and Parks), Recreation and Facilities, Miscellaneous (Harbormaster, Tree Warden, Memorial Day), Debt Service (principal and interest on notes, bonds, and lease/purchase payments), and Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Districts (operating expenses, salaries, wages, reimbursements, credit enhancement reimbursements, projects and assets, and debt service), with \$6,083,945 to be funded from estimated revenues, \$575,000 from unassigned General Fund Balance for debt reduction, \$4,322,500 from unassigned General Fund Balance for capital projects, \$4,000 from restricted Trust Fund Balance, \$314,712 from the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant as authorized by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and \$18,755,025 to be raised by property tax levy (\$1,517,147 of which is to be deposited to and appropriated from the Town's TIF District Special Revenue Fund).
