Town of Kennebunk Application for Permit to Blast

Please Note: *No person shall engage in blasting or detonation of explosive materials within the Town of Kennebunk without first obtaining a permit to conduct such operations from the Code Enforcement Officer. For the purposes of this Ordinance, blasting shall be defined as the use of explosives to break up or otherwise aid in the extraction or removal of rock or other consolidated natural or man-made formation.*

Note 1. Application shall be filed at least 2 weeks prior to commencing blasting operations and shall contain the following:

3. A map/plan showing the location(s) and description of the proposed blasting activity (attach to this application).
4. A map/plan showing the location of adjacent structures within 300' of blasting site, including buildings, wells, pools, etc. and the names of the owners of such properties (attach to this application).

6. Name, address and telephone number of Person Conducting Pre-blast and Post-blast Survey: _____

Pre-blast survey must include all existing structures and conditions on the site, adjacent to the site and within 300 feet of the site. Such pre-blast structural inspection survey shall be performed of all structures, including homes, foundations, driveways, roadbeds, swimming pools, wells and other buildings.

7. Proof that the entity applying for the permit to blast is properly licensed by the State of Maine and that the work will be performed
8. Evidence that notice of the proposed blasting operation has been sent by United States Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested to all landowners abutting the subject property of the application and within three hundred feet of the proposed blast site, as well as to all public utility companies (KKWWD, KSD, KL&P, CMP). Said notice shall indicate the location of the proposed blasting, approximate date and times that the blasting will occur and the name, address and telephone number of the entity that will actually perform the blasting operation. A copy of said notification together with a copy of the names and addresses of the landowners and a copy of the Return Receipts shall be filed with the Code Enforcement Office.
9. Proof that the blasting contractor has adequate liability insurance at a minimum amount of one million dollars to cover blasting operations.
10. A blasting permit fee as established by the Board of Selectmen. Permit Fee: **\$50.00**

Note 2. The Code Enforcement Officer shall issue a Blasting Permit within 2 weeks (14 days) of the receipt of a complete application form, fee and all supporting documentation as set forth above.
