

Kennebunk Fireworks Ordinance

WARNING

- Permits are required on July 4th and December 31st. Two additional permits per year, per household may be allowed.
- Renting a property? You **MUST** have written landlord permission to receive a fireworks permit.

Must Be
21 Years of Age



- Individuals must be 21 years of age or older to possess, purchase or use fireworks in the Town of Kennebunk.
- Permits must be requested at Kennebunk Fire Rescue Central Station on the day of discharge.



Remember...

- Fireworks must not be used within 20ft of any building
- Fireworks are not allowed on any public street, park or beach
- Consumer fireworks can only be sold directly to the public in the state of Maine. Not all consumer fireworks are allowed in Maine.

What is NOT Allowed?



Sky Lanterns

Also known as floating or Chinese lanterns, are illegal to use, buy, sell or possess in Maine.



Helicopters and Aerial Spinners

A tube containing more than 20 grams of chemical composition, with a propeller blade attached. Upon ignition, the rapidly spinning device rises into the air. A visible or audible effect may be produced at or near the height of flight.



Sky Rockets, Rocket Missiles and Bottle Rockets

Cylindrical tube containing not more than 20 grams of chemical composition with a wooden stick attached for guidance and stability. Rockets rise into the air upon ignition. A burst of color and/or sound may be produced at or near the height of flight.
