



KENNEBUNK MAY DAY FESTIVAL – May 5th

WE INVITE YOU TO BE PART OF OUR MARKET!



- The May Day Festival's craft market hours are advertised as 8:00am – 3:00pm – **rain or shine**.
- Set-up of your space can begin at **7:00am**. You must check-in by **7:30am** or you will be considered absent.
- Transporting goods to and from spaces is the **responsibility of the crafter**.
- If in one of our parks, set-up **must** be within the park and **not** along the sidewalks; **walks must be kept clear per Kennebunk Police Dept.**
- Signage for your space is allowed and encouraged, however signage at intersections is **not** – any signage found that was not placed by committee members **will be removed**.
- Parking is allowed at the site **only to unload and load** gear and products. For the remaining hours, free parking is provided nearby in Kennebunk public lots. Suggestions will be included with your confirmation.
- All payments, and this completed form, **must be received by Monday, April 30th**. A confirmation will be sent as soon as payment is received if an email/ mailing address is provided. After 10-days if you haven't received confirmation, PLEASE contact us.
- If we sell-out before this date; your payment will be returned to you, unless you want to be added to our wait-list or pre-pay for the following year. **In 2017 this event was COMPLETELY sold out by April 4th**.
- There is **no** electricity available to crafters at **any** of our markets. Running extension cords through the area from remote electrical sources to yours is **not** allowed under any circumstances and **will be** disconnected.
- This is an event celebrating the young and the young-at-heart so children **will be present at all locations**.
- We are a pet-friendly event; crafters are allowed to bring their pets if they are **well** behaved and **well** tended.
- For Lafayette Park and Rotary Park, set-up is on a first-come, first-select basis; **our limited volunteer numbers do not allow us to pre-mark spaces**.
- The cost of your 10'x10' table space is **\$30.00-\$50.00 – paid in advance**. No spaces are held until payment is received.

Market Locations:

- **Sold Out - 03/27/18** Rotary Park (go to www.kennebunkmaine.us, search “Rotary Park”) – set-up if first come, first select.
- **Sold Out - 03/06/18** Lafayette Park (go to www.kennebunkmaine.us, search “Lafayette Park”) – this site has many events targeted to young children; maypole dancing, face painting, pottery demonstrations and some live music – set-up is first come, first select.
- **Sold Out - 03/21/18** Waterhouse Center (go to www.kennebunkmaine.us, search “Waterhouse Center”) – there is NO cooking of any kind allowed at this location – spaces for this market will be assigned based on order of requests received. The first 28 spaces are under the roof, the last 7 are just outside the over-hang (unless an outdoor space is specifically requested).
