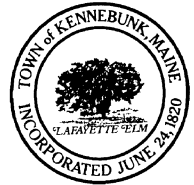

The Kennebunk Police Department has made an arrest following an investigation into a threat of workplace violence. Late Saturday night (November 3rd), Officers received information that a former employee of a Kennebunk business had communicated a threat thru another employee that he intended to return to the business with the intent of shooting a number of people. Following an investigation by Kennebunk Patrol Officers and Detectives, thirty-one-year-old Benjamin A. Mildner of Kennebunk was arrested at about 10:00 am on Sunday (November 4th), and charged with Terrorizing, a Class D misdemeanor. The investigation revealed that Mildner did not have access to any firearms. He was subsequently released after posting bail, with conditions that he not return to the business or have contact with the business's employees.
